
# THE IMPORTANCE OF RESEARCH INFRASTRUCTURE

## THE CFI MANDATE and MODEL

#### Our mandate is to:


Enhance the capacity of ultimate recipients to:

- a) attract and retain the world's top research talent;
- b) enable researchers to undertake world-class research and technology development that lead to social, economic and environmental benefits for Canada;
- c) train the next generation of researchers; and
- d) support private sector innovation and commercialization.

#### Our model

- a) provides 40% of infrastructure costs (with remainder provided by provinces, institutions and private sector);
- b) supports all areas of research;
- c) awards based on merit and excellence;
- d) CFI promotes the development of shared research facilities


